1. The A.P State Council of Higher Education has been receiving lists of admissions made by Managements of Non Minority and Minority Private Unaided B.Ed colleges through EdCET-2014 and EdCET-AC-2014 along with certificates for rectification of deficiencies in various phases for the academic year 2014-15 though the cutoff date for submission of admission lists was initially fixed at 15.11.2014 and subsequently extended to 30.11.2014.
2. As the practical and theory examinations for B.Ed course are scheduled to commence shortly in all Universities in A.P, such delayed submission of admission lists and certificates for rectification of deficiencies in various phases by the Managements cannot be processed at this point of time under the prevailing circumstances by the Competent Authority, APSCHE.
3. Hence, the candidates so admitted may appear for final examination at their risk subject to the condition that (i) the candidate cannot claim any equities in the event of the admission of the candidate made by the management is not in accordance with the rules or the certificate of qualifying examination is not genuine or recognized, (ii) the college shall obtain the receipt of provisional approval from the Competent Authority i.e. Chairman, AP State Council of Higher Education at a later date (iii) AFRC approves the admissions made under Categories A & B in case of SW-II and SW-III colleges to claim the Provisional/Original Degree from the University concerned.
4. The Competent Authority has permitted the Universities to scrutiny the proposals and deficiencies submitted by the colleges on the admissions made by them as per rules in force and accordingly approve the admissions made by the colleges.
5. The Registrars of the Universities in the State of Andhra Pradesh shall take action on para 4 of the proceedings accordingly.
