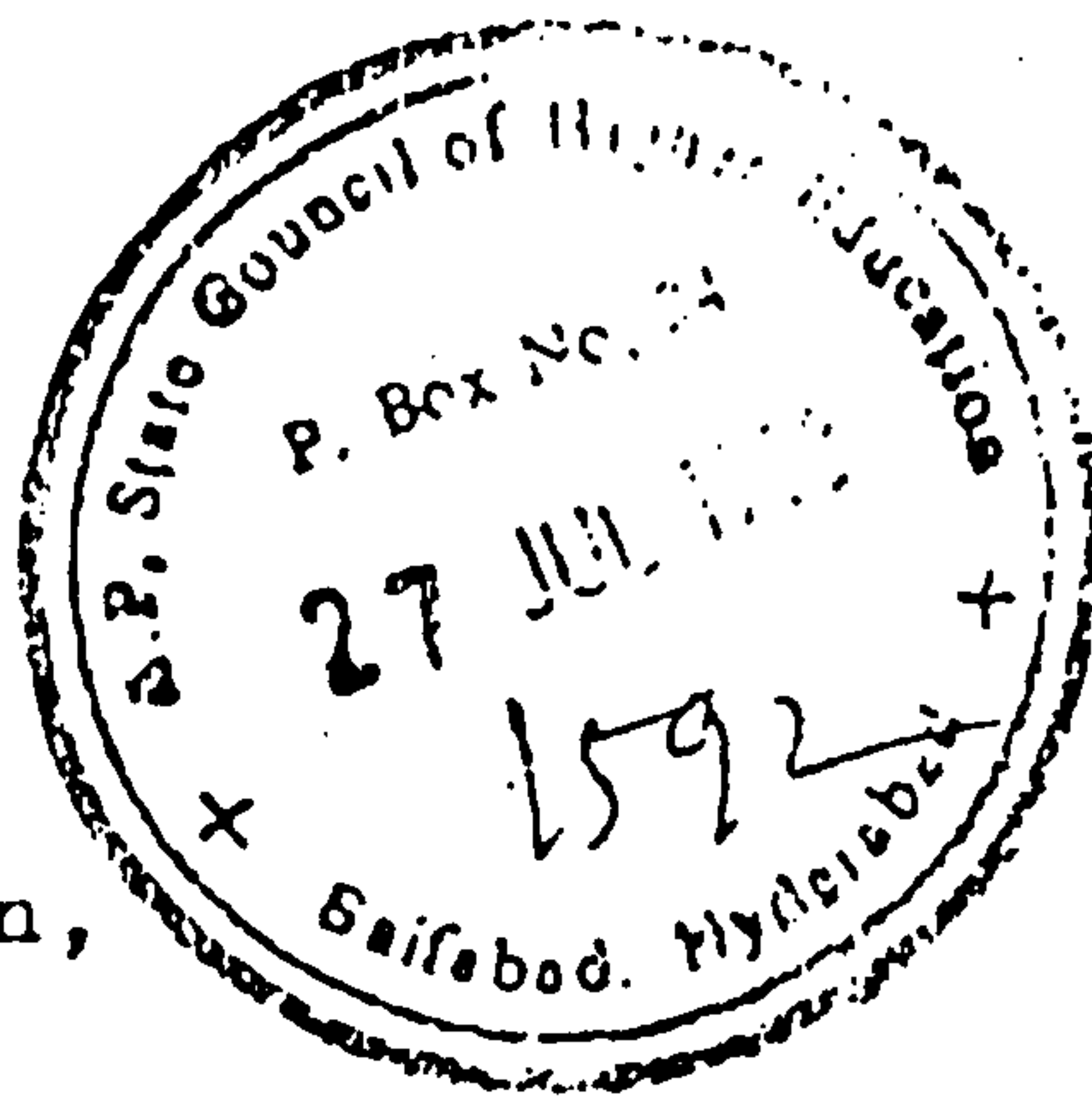

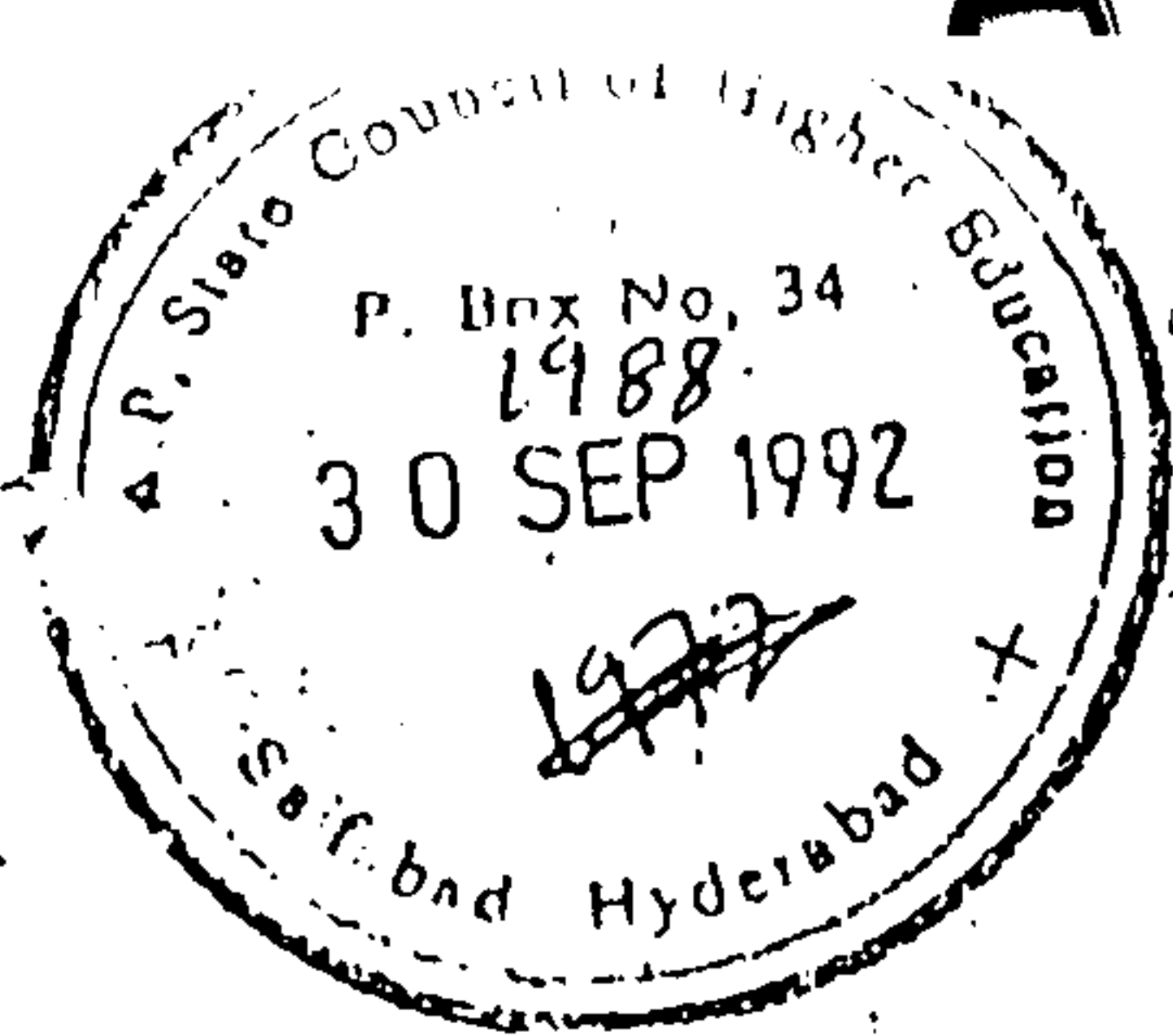

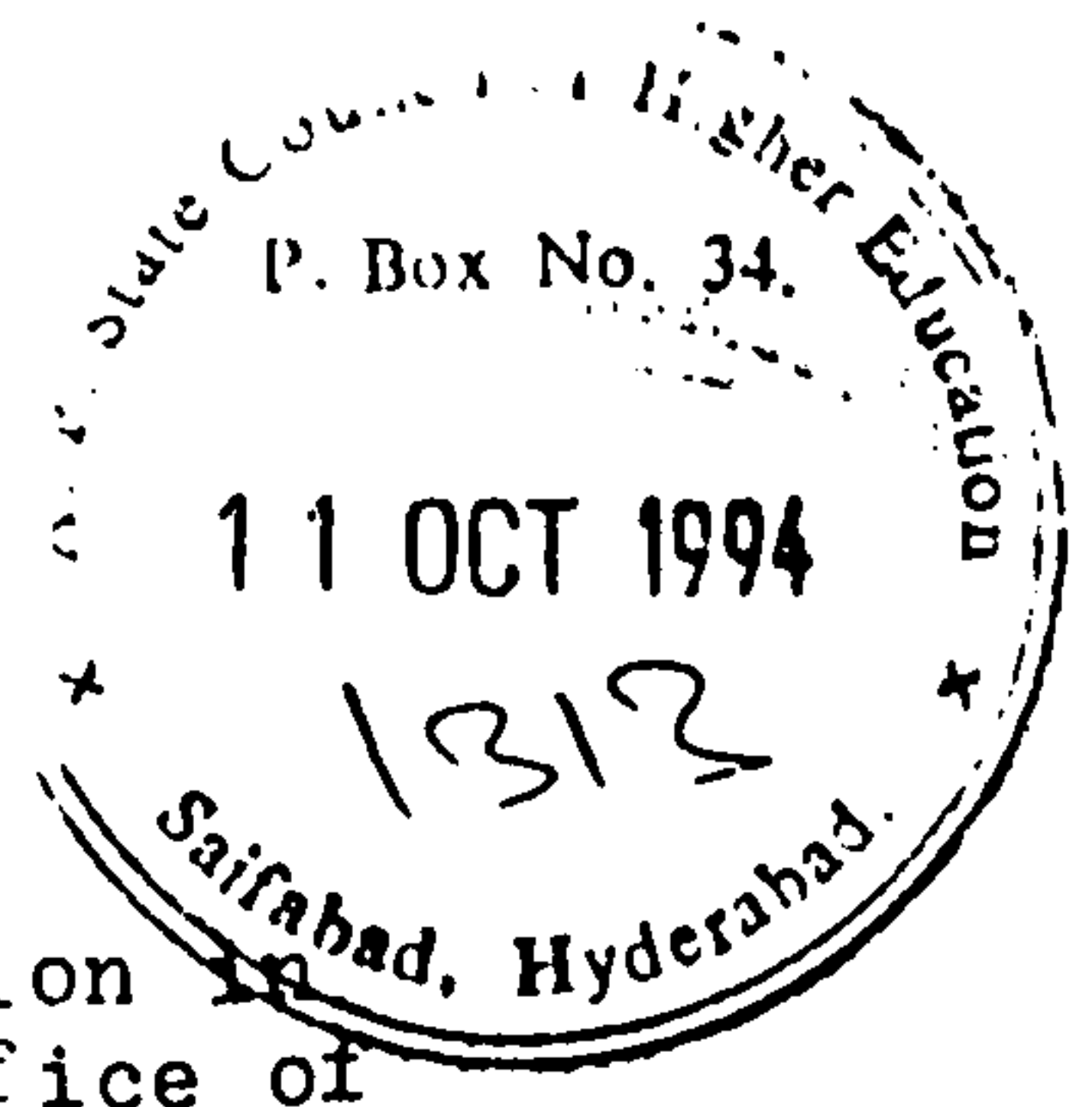

The Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education, Hyderabad in his D.O. letter read above has requested for up-gradation of the post of Deputy Director as Joint Director in view of the increased work load on account of the starting of three new Universities and starting of 21st Century Gurukulams for which the council needs a middle level Officer to co-ordinate the academic activities and also to support the Committee as the present Secretary who is the only middle level officer is already over burdened and the Council will not put additional burden on Government by asking for sanction of new post of Joint Director and he has requested to upgrade the existing post of Deputy Director as there is no additional financial commitment in respect of pay and allowances, if the post of Deputy Director is upgraded as Joint Director. The additional expenditure if any will be incurred by the Council from its internal resources. The Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education, Hyderabad has therefore finally requested the Government to upgrade the post of Deputy Director to Joint Director and the present Deputy Director may be appointed as Joint Director till he continues on deputation and after his repatriation the post of Joint Director will cease to operate keeping in view of the academic qualifications and experience of the present Deputy Director. During the above deputation period the vacancy of the Deputy Director will not be filled.

2. Government after careful examination of the matter have accepted the proposal of the Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education for the up-gradation of existing post of Deputy Director as Joint Director and the same may be filled with the present Deputy Director and will continue as long as he is on deputation and after his repatriation, the post of Joint Director will cease to operate. In the G.O. 1st read above, certain posts were created for A.P. State Council of Higher Education, Hyderabad. In the reference 3rd read above, the Secretary, A.P. State Council of Higher Education has informed that the Council has taken a decision to convert two posts of Junior Stenographers sanctioned in the G.O 1st read above, into that of Computer Operator and Data Entry Operator posts (one each), vide resolution No. 4.08 of the 50th meeting of the State Council held on 12.10.2001, so as to attend to the confidential work relating to the common entrance tests and other important policy decisions of the Council. Accordingly the Council has converted the said two posts of Junior Stenographers and appointed Sri T.V. Gangadhar and Sri D. Sreenath Reddy as Computer Operator and Data Entry Operator respectively on temporary basis with the minimum scale of pay of Rs. 3290-6550 (of 1999 pay scales) with all usual allowances with effect from 1.4.2005, keeping in view the administrative necessity. The Secretary, A.P. State Council of Higher Education has therefore, requested the Government to ratify the above action of the Council.

2) Government have examined the issue keeping in view that the A.P. State Council of Higher Education is an autonomous body and the services and posts of the Council are governed by a separate set of service rules, and decided to ratify the action of the A.P. In the circumstances reported by the Secretary, A.P. State Council of Higher Education in the letter read above, after careful examination, Government hereby extend the Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules 1980 to the employees of Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education subject to meeting the pension liability from their own funds without any financial commitment on the part of the Government either now or in future and also subject to the following conditions :

1. The A.P. State Council of Higher Education will create and constantly subscribe to pension fund meant exclusively to meet this pension commitment and any further commitments that may arise due to the sanction of Dearness Relief, Pay Revision and any other sanctions.
2. The Pension liability will be met entirely from its own funds and the A.P. State Council for Higher Education will not, seek funds from the Government either now or in future..
3. A separate fund to meet the cost of Gratuity payments, encashment leave etc., will also be set up and be funded exclusively by the Council from out of its own funds and it shall not seek any funds from the Government either now or in future for this purpose.
4. The Pension Fund and Gratuity Fund will conform the guidelines prescribed by the Council in this regard.
5. The Council shall extend GPF Rules to the employees of A.P. State Council of Higher Education, Hyderabad
6. However, A.P. Revised Pension Rules 1980 will not apply to those employees who join the Council on or after 1.9.2004 and for whom a separate contributory pension scheme may be worked out.
