Show Cause No. APSCHE/AC-103- ANU/Not functioning-SCN/ 2019

Sub: APSCHE – Academic Cell – ANU area –Colleges which are holding permission and not functioning for the last three years – denied the access to higher education to all sections of the Society in the locality concerned – Show Cause Notice to the Colleges – issued - Regarding.

ORDER :-

1. D.Venkata Subbaiah (DVS) Degree College, Darsi, Prakasam District obtained provisional permission from the Competent Authority in the year 1995-96 for running a new Private Unaided Degree College. The Competent Authority accorded provisional permission to the Society / College in the address entry with a view to provide access to higher education to all sections of the Society and to improve Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER), after identifying the need in the locality and granted permission to the Degree College.
2. As per Rule 9 (2) (b) of G.O.Ms.No. 29 dt. 5.2.1987, a Private College shall be accorded temporary permission /recognition / affiliation which is renewable annually for a period of five years relaxable to 10 years in deserving case only, by which time prescribed conditions must be fulfilled for grant of permanent recognition / affiliation.
3. Whereas the Competent Authority noted that the Society / College in the address entry having provisional permission from this Competent Authority has not obtained affiliation for the last three years, which is a pre-requisite to run the college, and thereby the College in the address entry is not functioning for the last three years and denied the access to higher education thereon to all sections of the Society. This conduct of the Society and the College amounts to committing a serious default while still holding permission to run the College from the Competent Authority, thereby monopolising the activity of catering to educational needs in the area/locality.
4. As per Rule 11 (1) of G.O.Ms.NO. 29 dt. 5.2.1987, the Competent Authority shall withdraw permission/recognition/affiliation granted to the private educational institution when the institution has failed to fulfill any of the conditions prescribed for permission/recognition/affiliation
5. In this background, this show cause notice is being issued to the Society / College in the address entry to explain why permission should not be withdrawn by this Competent Authority for not running the College during the last three years and not complied with one of the conditions prescribed by this Competent Authority that the College should obtain affiliation from the University concerned and thereby denied the access to higher education to all sections of the society in the locality concerned. This explanation of the Society /College along with the copies of the permission proceedings issued by the Competent Authority to establish the College and affiliation orders of the university should reach this Competent Authority within (1) month from the date of this notice. In the event no explanation along with the documents specified above are not received within one month, it will be presumed by the Competent Authority that the College has no explanation to submit and thereby permitted the Competent Authority to withdraw permission accorded for running the College and to take further action in the matter.

The Competent Authority accorded provisional permission to the Society / College in the address entry with a view to provide access to higher education to all sections of the Society and to improve Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER), after identifying the need in the locality and granted permission to the Degree College.
2.
