As per Rule 9 (2) (b) of G.O.Ms.NO. 29 dt. 5.2.1987, it is crystal clear that any private college shall be accorded temporary affiliation which is renewable annually for a period of five years relaxable to 10 years in deserving cases only, by which time prescribed conditions must be fulfilled for grant of permanent affiliation. In fact, after completion of 5 years, the College must necessarily obtain permanent affiliation by owning its own buildings. In default, the affiliation is liable to be withdrawn. This stipulation is not directory but mandatory as per the Judgement of Hon'ble High Court reported in 2004 (6) ALT 354.

2. In this context, the Competent Authority ie APSCHE issued Notifications in 2015-16, 2016-17 and finally in 2017-18 for obtaining annual or periodical Extension of Permission (EoP) for running the Degree College in the leased premises in order to monitor shifting of the existing colleges in the leased premises to their own building in consonance with Rule 9 (2) (b) of G.O.Ms.No. 29.

3. The Competent Authority noticed certain Societies / Colleges have not applied for Extension of Permission or made an application to shift to their own building to this Competent Authority as per rules in vogue. This conduct of the Societies and the Colleges amounts to non-fulfilment of conditions prescribed while according permission to run the College from the Competent Authority.

4. The Competent Authority ie AP State Council of Higher Education, vide G.O.Ms.No. 278 Education Department dated 24.7.1995 read with G.O.Ms.No. 29 dt. 5.2.1987, issued Show Cause notices, vide No. APSCHE/AS-152-EoA-General-SC/2017 Dt. 29.4.2017, to Colleges functioning in the rented buildings for not shifting the Colleges into own accommodation and/ or for not applying EoP in order to comply with the Judgement of Hon'ble High Court reported in 2004 (6) ALT 354. In the said notice, it was clearly mentioned that *in the event of non-receipt of explanation received within 15 days, the Competent Authority shall take further steps to withdraw the permission granted to run the college from the first batch of the students of all Courses in the College for the academic year 2017-18.*

5. The Competent Authority has clearly mentioned, vide Show Cause No. APSCHE/AS-152-EoA-General-SC/2017 Dt. 19.05.2017, that the Managements / Colleges, who have not submitted application for Extension of Permission and given an Undertaking to the Competent Authority, *should not make admissions into 1st year of all courses for 2017-18. It was further intimated to the Managements / Colleges that such colleges shall be deemed to have been functioning without permission and thereby making un-authorized admissions and cheating as well as damaging the academic career of the students.*

6. The Competent Authority noticed that the Private Unaided Degree College in the address entry has been functioning despite point (1) to (5) above and having not complied with the above referred judgement of Hon'ble High Court, the provisions of AP Education Act 1982, the Rules issued thereon and show cause Notices issued earlier, in spite of granting substantial time for compliance under Section 21 of AP Education Act 1982

7. In view of the above serious non-compliance with the conditions prescribed while granting permission, the Competent Authority has constituted an Inquiry Committee to enquire into violation of Rules, wilful disobedience and non-compliance of the Judgement of Hon'ble High Court by such Private Unaided Degree Colleges, before withdrawing the Permission accorded by this Authority and consequential withdrawal of the affiliation by the concerned university under Section 21 (3) of AP Education Act 1982 read with Rule 9 (2) (b) and Rule 11 of GO Ms.No. 29 dt. 5.2.1987.



Sub : APSCHE – Academic Cell – Constitution of Inquiry Committee - Enquiry against those Colleges for their wilful disobedience, non-compliance of Rules and not responding to Show Cause Notice issued by the Competent Authority – Final opportunity to Colleges to attend before the Inquiry Committee and submit their written statement as per the schedule mentioned in the notice – Final Show cause notice issued – Regarding.

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1. As per Rule 9 (2) (b) of G.O.Ms.NO. 29 dt. 5.2.1987, it is crystal clear that any private college shall be accorded temporary affiliation which is renewable annually for a period of five years relaxable to 10 years in deserving cases only, by which time prescribed conditions must be fulfilled for grant of permanent affiliation. In fact, after completion of 5 years, the College must necessarily obtain permanent affiliation by owning its own buildings. In default, the affiliation is liable to be withdrawn. This stipulation is not directory but mandatory as per the Judgement of Hon'ble High Court reported in 2004 (6) ALT 354.

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8. Therefore, this is the final notice / opportunity to the Secretary of the Educational Society concerned / the Secretary and Correspondent of the Private Unaided Degree College in the address entry which falls under point (7) above to personally appear and represent before the Inquiry Committee as scheduled hereunder along with their written statement.

In case the Management of the College fails to appear and represent before the Inquiry Committee, the Competent Authority will take a decision to withdraw the permission already granted to the College in the address entry in pursuance of the powers conferred under Section 21 (3) of AP Education Act 1982 read with Rule 11 of GO Ms.No. 29 dt. 5.2.1987.
