PUBLIC NOTICE

**Inviting suggestions on conduct of survey
to assess the need for New Private Unaided Degree Colleges**

- (i) There are 1117 Private Unaided Degree Colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- (ii) Out of these 1117 Colleges, 992 Private Unaided Degree College do not have 2 (f) and 12 (b) of UGC Act ie lack of recognition and financial support from UGC.
- (iii) 1021 Private Unaided Degree Colleges do not have NAAC Accreditation status due to lack required instructional and infrastructural facilities.
- (iv) 672 Private Unaided Degree Colleges are functioning in the rented buildings from 5 years of their existence to more than 25 years of its existence in gross violation of rules.
- (v) 522 Private Unaided Degree Colleges have less than 50% admissions in under graduate courses.
- (vi) 194 Private Unaided Degree Colleges have been functioning without Extension of Approval of the Council in the State in gross violation of rules.

In spite of the above status of the existing Private Unaided Degree Colleges, the AP State Council of Higher Education has been receiving complaints on the functioning of existing degree colleges and also receiving requisitions for establishment of new Private Unaided Degree Colleges, change of managements of the existing private unaided degree colleges and shifting of colleges from one mandal to another mandal under the pretext that the admissions are poor etc and some of the existing Colleges are approaching Court of Law on the ground that there is no requirement for sanction of new colleges in their localities.

The A.P State Council of Higher Education has constituted a Committee to examine the present status of the functioning of existing Private Unaided Degree Colleges and to conduct survey so as to assess the need for New Private Unaided Degree Colleges in the localities / mandals located in the State of A.P

The Council invites suggestions from all stake holders including Academicians, Research Scholars, Students, Educational Institutions, Parents and Public representatives on the modalities for conduct of survey so as to assess the need of more Private Unaided Degree Colleges in the State. The suggestions will be helpful to the Committee constituted to make their recommendations.
