ORDER:-

In the reference read above, orders were issued framing guidelines for award and disbursement of Post - Matric Scholarships to Economically Backward Classes (EBCs) students studying in Polytechnics, Professional Colleges (other than Medical) and University Colleges.

2. In the year 2008-09 an amount of Rs.30.00 Crores is provided in the budget. The amount shall be drawn from the following Heads of accounts.

1)	2202-General Education MH-07 Scholarships SH-04 Scholarships and Stipends- 340 Scholarships and stipends -	3.00 Crores
2)	2202-General Education MH-800 Other expenditure SH-05 EPP Scholarships 340 340 Scholarships and Stipends -	2.00 Crores
3)	2202-General Education MH-107 Scholarships GH-11 Normal State Plan SH-04 Scholarships for EBC students. 340 Scholarships and Stipends -	25.00 Crores

Total :-		30.00 Crores

3. The Government also direct that out of the total amount of Rs.30.00 Crores, an amount of Rs. 10 Crores shall be earmarked for grant of EBC scholarships to 13 specified castes namely (1) Ayyaraka (2) Kasi Kapidi (3) Patra (4) Gajula Balija (5) Nagaralu (6) Pondara (7) Kurakala (8) Quresh (Muslim Butchers) (9) Pala-ekari, (10) Kapu (11) Balija (12) Telaga and (13) Ontaries, and the remaining amount of Rs.20 crores shall be utilized for grant of scholarships to eligible EBC students belonging to the other communities. It is also ordered that within the earmarked amounts of Rs. 10 Crores and Rs. 20 Crores, as mentioned above, 25% shall be allocated for award of scholarships to students of Polytechnics, 60% to those studying Graduate courses and 15% to the students of Post Graduate Courses

4. The Commissioners of Collegiate Education and Technical Education shall take necessary action accordingly while releasing scholarship amounts for the benefit of EBC students in the State.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (Exp.HE) Department vide their U.O.Note No.11867/443/Expr.H.E/08, dated 10-09-2008.
