In compliance of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> cited Judgements and as contemplated in the 3<sup>rd</sup> cited G.O. the Government of Andhra Pradesh constituted the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC) and entrusted it with power of fixation of Fee Structures in Private Unaided Professional Colleges with Hon'ble Sri Justice R.Bayapu Reddy, (Retired) as the Chairman in the 4th cited reference.

In view of the observations made by the Supreme Court in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> cited judgements and the issuance of the rules of admissions for various Professional courses in GO's mentioned below, the A. F. R. C. proposes to review the fee structure for Engineering, Pharmacy, Architecture, MBA, MCA, Law and B.Ed. courses offered in the Private Unaided Professional colleges for the academic year 2009-10.

The Managements of all the concerned Private Un-aided Professional colleges in the State as referred above, are hereby required to submit in writing to the Committee their proposed fee structures separately in respect of A-Category and B-Category seats for each course as contemplated in the G.Os along with necessary information regarding the aspects mentioned in the Annexure given in this Notification in justification and proof of the fee proposals made and the information furnished for the scrutiny and decision of the Committee.

The Fee proposals along with all the required information shall be submitted so as to reach the **Office of the A.F.R.C., for matters relating to Fixation of Fee Structure in Private Un-Aided Professional Colleges, 1st floor, South Wing, Gagan Vihar, M.J.Road, Nampally, Hyderabad-500 001** on or before 15 -05 -2009 by 5.00 p.m. Non-submission of the proposals would be construed as willingness on the part of the Managements of the concerned Colleges to accept the decision of the Committee arrived at on its own assessment on the basis of the relevant material available before it.

**ANNEXURE  
RECURRING AND NON-RECURRING EXPENDITURE BEING INCURRED BY  
THE INSTITUTION relating to :**

1. Annual expenditure on Teaching staff and Non-Teaching staff.
2. Annual Expenditure on equipment and infrastructure such as, Laboratory, Library, Computers etc., and on Developmental work.
3. Annual Expenditure for maintenance of utilities such as Power, Water, Transport, Telecommunications, Student Support Services, Faculty development etc.,

9. Whether Accreditation is given by the apex bodies for any Course?
10. Any other information felt necessary by the Institution for fixation of Fee-Structures.
