(In terms of G.O. Ms. No.26 Higher Education (U.E.II)(2)) Department, dated 24-3-2004)

ELIGIBILITY FOR LAW CET-2009 3 year LL.B./B.L. Course: The Candidates for 3 year LL.B./B.L. should have passed any Graduate Degree of a recognized University with 45% of aggregate marks or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the Universities concerned.

5 Year LL.B./B.L. Course: The Candidates for 5 year LL.B./B.L. should have passed two year Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) with 45% of aggregate marks or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the University concerned or the Board of Intermediate Education, A.P.

Note : There is a relaxation of 5% of marks in the above qualifying examinations for 3year/5year Law course in favour of the Candidates belonging to SC/ST.

1. A candidate appearing for the above qualifying examinations may also take the Law Common Entrance Test in anticipation of results. In case of such students who appear for the entrance test, pending the result of the qualifying examination, their entry shall be subject to their securing eligible marks in the said qualifying examinations.
2. The applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation/post graduation through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission in the law courses.
3. **Age on admission : (a)** Subject to the conditions stipulated by the Govt. of A.P., on this behalf, the maximum age for seeking admission into 5year Law Degree program is limited to twenty years in case of general category of applicants and to twenty two years in case of applicants from SC, ST and other Backward communities.
(b) Subject to the conditions stipulated by the Govt. of A.P., the maximum age for seeking admission into 3 year Law Degree Program is limited to thirty years in case of general category of applicants and to thirty five years in case of applicants from SC, ST and other Backward communities.
